



FRENCH STUDIES CONFERENCE

CALL FOR PAPERS

The Department of Romance Languages at Monash University is hosting a French Studies conference from 17-19 September 1993 to mark the thirtieth anniversary of the *Australian Journal of French Studies* and *Essays in French Literature*. Offers of papers are now called for.

The conference will have no single theme but papers will be grouped according to their subject. We would like to encourage papers which engage with any issues concerning French studies in Australia today. Papers which deal with current debates in literary and cultural theory, French-Australian relations, issues in language teaching pedagogy, and which reflect past and present strengths in Australian French Studies (for example, nineteenth-century and twentieth-century studies, narratology, the history of reading) will be especially welcome. In view of the nature of this occasion, papers on French journals and authors' relations with them will also be welcome.

This occasion will also provide an opportunity to launch an Australian Society for French Studies.
